What is Encephalitis?

Encephalitis is inflammation of the brain.

There are two types of Encephalitis-viral
Encephalitis (which can be caused by any
virus, as simple as chicken pox, a cold sore
or a common cold) and auto-immune
Encephalitis.

Symptoms can be a headache or flu like feeling, to more severe symptoms, such as seizures, hallucinations, un-characteristic behaviour and in many cases loss of consciousness or a coma.

Encephalitis is a life threatening, severely life-changing illness often causing an Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) and other life long complications.
